Presentation of the candidates

Jesus said, 'Let the children come to me. Do not stop them.'

We thank God for *N* who *has* come to be baptised today. Christ loves *them* and welcomes *them* into his Church. So I ask you all:

Will you support *N* as they begin their journey of faith? **We will.**

Will you help *them* to live and grow within God's family? **We will.**

The president then addresses the parents and godparents

God knows each of us by name and we are his. Parents and godparents, you speak for *N* today. Will you pray for *them*, and help *them* to follow Christ? **We will.**

Or the president asks those candidates for baptism who are able to answer

Do you wish to be baptised? I do.

Testimony may follow. The president addresses the whole congregation

We thank God for *N* who *has* come to be baptised today. Christ loves *them* and welcomes *them* into his Church. Will you support *them* on their journey of faith?

All We will.

The decision

The president addresses the candidates directly, or their parents, godparents and sponsors

We all wander far from God and lose our way: Christ comes to find us and welcomes us home. In baptism we respond to his call. Therefore I ask:

Do you turn away from sin? I do.

Do you reject evil? I do.

Do you turn to Christ as Saviour? I do.

Do you trust in him as Lord? I do.

Prayer over the water

Father, bless this water, that your servants who are washed in it may be made one with Christ in his death and in his resurrection, to be cleansed and delivered from all sin. Send your Holy Spirit upon them to bring them to new birth in the family of your Church, and raise them with Christ to full and eternal life. For all might, majesty, authority and power are yours, now and forever.

All Amen.

Profession of faith

The president addresses the congregation

Let us affirm, together with these who are being baptised, our common faith in Jesus Christ.

Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

All I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again?

All I believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

All I believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

All This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Baptism

If the candidate(s) can answer for themselves

N, is this your faith?

Each candidate answers in their own words, or says

This is my faith.

The president dips each candidate in water, or pours water on them, saying

N, I baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All Amen.

Signing with the cross

The president makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each candidate

Christ claims you for his own. Receive the sign of his cross. Do not be ashamed of Christ. You are his for ever.

All Stand bravely with him against all the powers of evil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

> May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

All Amen.

Giving of light

Receive this light. This is to show that you have passed from darkness into light.


All Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.
